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## 2014 ANNALYCE NAPA VALLEY

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The name Annalyce is Laura's middle name. It comes from the joining of the names of her grandmothers - Anne and Alyce. We have begun sourcing Sangiovese from a vineyard near Soda Canyon off Silverado Trail to add to our Meritaggio. As we picked our Sangioveses we bled off some of the clear sweet juice prior to fermenting the must and fermented it separately. What resulted was a beautifully aromatic Rosé with great acidity and a distinctive fruit profile.

10% Nebbiolo  
10% Merlot  
5% Cabernet Franc

*TASTING NOTES:*

A bright salmon pink rose offers aromas of candied plums and cherries followed by notes of ripe peach and raspberry. There are subtle hints of rose petals and kefir lime. The palate is focused and texturally soft yet offers a mouthwatering minerality that finishes with Asian pear and honeydew melon. Best from 2014 to 2016.
